### EAGLE SCOUT PRESENTATION

Jerry Acheson introduced Eagle Scout, Timothy Miles. Miles began his Eagle Scout project at Fallen Leaf Lake Park in September of 2011 and finished in January of 2012. He shared photos of his finished project, which is 65 feet of a wooden walkway at Fallen Leaf Lake Park. In response to Lorenz, Miles stated that he received donations from Exterior Wood, Do It Best and Parkrose Hardware.

The Parks Commission thanked Timothy Miles for the great work on his project.

### PROJECT UPDATES

**Camas Community Center** – Acheson stated that the roof at the Community Center needs to be replaced and he's looking into funding for the project. He added that it's been repaired several times and keeps leaking

**City Council Workshop on March 5<sup>th</sup>** – Acheson will attend the Council Workshop on March 5<sup>th</sup> to present the following items; Moose Lodge proposal, meeting time change, alcohol use at Fallen Leaf Lake Park, Park Host location and Special Event requirements.

**American Red Cross** – Acheson stated that the ARC will charge an additional \$2 fee per student for swim lessons so the lesson fees will increase by that amount for this upcoming Summer season.

### **OTHER ITEMS**

**Fallen Leaf Lake Park**– Lloyd Halverson stressed the importance of good communication between the Parks Commission and City Council regarding such issues as the rules and regulations for Fallen Leaf Lake Park. Halverson inquired about the possibility of having a separate fee schedule for Civic groups to reserve Fallen Leaf Lake. Brent Erickson stated that the Commission will move forward with Halverson’s recommendation to have staff implement Civic fees for Fallen Leaf Lake Park and present it to City Council on March 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Moose Lodge** – Abrahamsen stated that she visited the Moose Lodge and thinks it’s important to involve the community’s input in the planning stages of the lodge. In response to Abrahamsen’s suggestion to speak with someone at the Firstenberg Center, Marshall stated that the CCDC has done several studies on the Firstenberg Center.
