

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**Transportation Impact Fees**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that there will be a legislative public hearing to consider a *2012 Transportation Impact Fees Study* and proposed amendments to Camas Municipal Code (CMC), Chapter 3.88 *Impact Fees on New Development*. The amendments likely would modify the rate at which the City of Camas calculates transportation impact fees. The public hearing will be held on **Monday, May 21, 2012, at 7:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter in Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, located at 616 NE Fourth Avenue, Camas, Washington, before City Council.
