

ORDINANCE NO. 1977

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 13.64.040 of the Camas Municipal Code by prohibiting disposal into the city sanitary sewer system of septic tank and chemical toilet waste generated outside of the city limits of Camas.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Section 13.64.040 of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

13.64.040 - Septage Users. There is imposed upon customers of the City of Camas water and sewer utility who have septic tanks or chemical toilets and reside within the city limits of Camas a service charge of \$0.05 dollars per gallon when waste from the septic tank or chemical toilet is dumped into the city sanitary sewer system.

Septic tank waste or chemical toilet waste generated outside of the city limits of Camas may not be dumped into the City of Camas sanitary sewer system.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
