Section I

Section 13.52.030(B) is amended to provide as follows:


13.52.030 - Imposition.

B. There shall be no water system development charge imposed for the installation of an additional meter installed to an existing residential customer service line which meter is installed for irrigation purposes pursuant to the provisions of Section 13.36.020.


Section II
