

ORDINANCE NO. 1987

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$21,500.00 from the General Fund to pay for salary and personnel benefits for an additional building inspector, and amending the Budget of the City of Camas for the year 1994 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the substantial increase in construction activity in the city requires that the City employ an additional building inspector, and

WHEREAS, no salary or personnel benefits were budgeted for such position in the 1994 budget, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditure, now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$21,500.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for the cost of an additional building inspector, and is allocated as follows:
