

ORDINANCE NO. 1990

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$6,000.00 from the City Sanitary Fund to purchase 100 additional yard waste containers for the yard waste recycling program, and amending the Budget of the City of Camas for the year 1994 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore adopted a program for yard waste recycling, and

WHEREAS, the City is responsible for purchasing yard debris containers for such program, and

WHEREAS, the number of people enrolling in the yard waste recycling program exceeds the number of containers heretofore purchased by the City, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the City Sanitary Fund to acquire additional containers, now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$6,000.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the City Sanitary Fund to pay for the cost of an additional 100 containers for yard waste recycling, and is allocated as follows:
