

ORDINANCE NO. 2015

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$90,000.00 from the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for sales tax and business and occupation tax on water-sewer sales and water-sewer development fees, to pay for un-anticipated repairs on the sanitary sewer line, and to pay for public utility costs in excess of anticipated expenses, and amending the Budget of the City of Camas for the year 1994 to provide for such expenditures.

WHEREAS, the City has incurred sales tax and business and occupation taxes on water-sewer sales and water-sewer development fees in the amount of \$40,000.00 in excess of the budgeted amount, and

WHEREAS, the City has incurred \$25,000.00 in repair expense to the sewer line which was not provided for in the 1994 Budget, and

WHEREAS, the City has incurred public utility costs in the amount of \$25,000.00 in excess of anticipated costs, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for such expenditures,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$90,000.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the Water-Sewer Fund, and is allocated as follows:


Ordinance 1965 and the Budget of the City of Camas for the year 1994 are amended to provide for the aforesated expenditures.


Section III

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for such expenditures,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:
