AN ORDINANCE repealing Section 2.68.060(B)  
of the Camas Municipal Code.

WHEREAS, Section 2.68.060 of the Camas Municipal Code permits  
the Council to grant employees a leave of absence without pay for  
a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, and

WHEREAS, Subsection B of Section 2.68.060 of the Camas Municipal  
Code provides that employees of the fire department, police department  
and city library are not entitled to leaves of absence without  
pay, and

WHEREAS, there is no longer any justification distinguishing  
between employees of the police department, fire department and  
city library from other employees of the city,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Section 2.68.060(B) of the Camas Municipal Code is hereby  
repealed.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5)  
days from and after its publication according to law.
