

ORDINANCE NO. 2033

AN ORDINANCE adding a new sub-section to Section 13.40.010 of the Camas Municipal Code by adopting regulations for water meters for multi-family residential units.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

There is hereby added to Section 13.40.010 of the Camas Municipal Code a new sub-section to provide as follows:

13.40.010 - Meters - Installation - Reading - Accuracy.

- q. Separate water meters shall be installed for each dwelling unit in a townhouse, condominium, or other multi-family dwelling configuration where individual dwelling units are separately owned. Single meters may be installed to serve multi-family residential structures when said structures and the units therein remain under a single ownership.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
