

ORDINANCE NO. 2034

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$45,000.00 from the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for the upsizing of a water line, and amending the budget for the year 1995 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the City desires to upsize 2,835 linear feet of water line from eight-inch pipe to eighteen-inch pipe, and

WHEREAS, the water line to be upsized will serve the new middle school of Camas School District No. 117, and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of said project is \$58,500.00, and

WHEREAS, \$13,500.00 has previously been appropriated for water lines in the 1995 budget, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for the balance of said project, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$45,000.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for the upsize of a water line from eight inches to eighteen inches, and is allocated as follows:


Ordinance 2011 and the budget for the City of Camas for the year 1995 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.


Section III
