

ORDINANCE NO. 2018

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$53,000.00 from the General Fund to pay for salary, benefits, and other expenses associated with hiring a new police officer.

WHEREAS, the City has hired a new police officer, and

WHEREAS, the City has incurred expenses in advertising and recruiting for the position, and

WHEREAS, the City will incur salary, benefit, and other expenses related to the hiring of a new police officer, and

WHEREAS, such expenses were not provided for in the 1995 Budget, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditures, now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$49,500.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the General Fund and the sum of \$3,500.00 is also appropriated from unappropriated reserves designated for drug enforcement in the General Fund, and said appropriations are allocated as follows:




