

ORDINANCE NO. 2053

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 16.40.020 of the Camas Municipal Code by increasing the SEPA application fee to \$350.00.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Section 16.40.020 of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

16.40.020 Threshold Determination: For every environmental checklist the City reviews when it is lead agency, the City shall collect a fee of \$350.00 from the proponent of the proposal prior to undertaking the threshold determination. The time periods provided for by this title for making a threshold determination shall not begin to run until payment of the fee. When the City completes the environmental checklist at the applicant's request or under Section 16.16.040(c) of this chapter, an additional \$50.00 shall be collected.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
