

ORDINANCE NO. 2063

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$54,000.00 from the Water Construction Fund to pay for repair expenses to the Fisher Basin Watermain Intertie, and amending the Budget for the Year 1996 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, flooding in February caused damage to the Fisher Basin Watermain Intertie construction project, and

WHEREAS, rehabilitation expenses on the shoulder and ditch of N.W. 38th Avenue cost \$54,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the Water Construction Fund to pay for such expenditure, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$54,000.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the Water Construction Fund to pay for flood rehabilitation expenses on N.W. 38th Avenue, and is allocated as follows:

The Budget of the City of Camas for the Year 1996 is amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.
