

ORDINANCE NO. 2064

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$43,200.00 from the General Fund to pay for consultant's fees to the Education Service District 112 in connection with the planning and construction of the new police facility, and amending the Budget for the Year 1996 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the Council has entered into an agreement with the Educational Service District 112 whereby ESD will provide facilities, planning and construction management services for the planning and construction of the new police facility; and

WHEREAS, the estimated expense for such services is \$43,200.00; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditure, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$43,200.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for consultant services for the planning and construction of the new police facility, and is allocated as follows:


Ordinance 2045 and the Budget of the City of Camas for the Year 1996 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.


Section III
