

ORDINANCE NO. 2045

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$20,000.00 from the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for engineering services in connection with the repair of the Crown View Plaza Waste Water Pump Station, and amending the Budget for the Year 1996 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the Crown View Plaza Waste Water Pump Station is in need of repair and improvement, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to hire an outside engineer to perform an alternative analysis, design services, and engineering during the construction process, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of said services is \$20,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for such expenditure, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$20,000.00 is hereby appropriated from unappropriated funds in the Water-Sewer Fund to pay for repair and improvement expenses in connection with the Crown View Plaza Waste Water Pump Station, and is allocated as follows:

Ordinance No. 2045 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 1996 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.


Section III
