WHEREAS, the council has determined that such reviews are best conducted by third party consultants, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the professional services for such reviews is \$220,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the general fund to pay for such expenditures, now, therefore,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:



Ordinance No. 2045 and the budget for the year 1996 are amended to provide for the aforesated expenditure.




