

ORDINANCE NO. 2089  
2,475,000.00

AN ORDINANCE appropriating ~~\$2,300,000.00~~ from the Police Facility Construction Fund to pay for construction of the new police facility, and amending the budget for the year 1996 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the City has elected to proceed with construction of a new police facility, and  
WHEREAS, in order to finance the cost of such facility, the City will issue General  
Obligation Bonds, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of constructing the facility is ~~\$2,300,000.00~~, and 2,475,000.00

WHEREAS, such expenditure was not provided for in the budget for the year 1996,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS  
AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

2,475,000.00  
The sum of ~~\$2,300,000.00~~ is appropriated from the Police Facility Construction Fund to pay for the construction cost of the new police facility, and is allocated as follows:
