

ORDINANCE NO. 2103

AN ORDINANCE adopting by reference certain provisions of the revised Code of Washington constituting misdemeanors and gross misdemeanors.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section II


The City Clerk is directed to keep on file in the Finance Department of the City of Camas for use and examination by the public of the text and any amendments or additions thereto of each statute adopted herein by reference.

Section III

The Council finds that an emergency exists in that effective January 1, 1997, all cities are responsible under substitute Senate Bill 6211 for the prosecution, adjudication, sentencing and incarceration of misdemeanor and gross misdemeanor offenses committed by adults in their respective jurisdictions whether filed under state law or city ordinance. The Council therefore designates this ordinance as a public emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate protection of public health, safety, property, and peace, and directs that it shall be effective upon adoption.
