

ORDINANCE NO. 2109

AN ORDINANCE transferring \$70,000.00 from the General Fund to the Street Fund, appropriating \$70,000.00 from the Street Fund to pay for additional street overlays and for a professional services contract with a geo-technical firm for monitoring of a landslide, and amending the Budget for the Year 1997 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the Street Fund has incurred unanticipated expenses in monitoring a landslide, which has necessitated the hiring of a geo-technical firm at a cost of \$20,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to undertake an additional \$50,000.00 in street overlays, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated monies in the General Fund to pay for such expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$70,000.00 is hereby transferred from the General Fund to the Street Fund,

Section II

The sum of \$70,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Fund to pay for geo-technical professional services and additional street overlays, and as allocated at follows:

Section III

Ordinance 2096 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 1997 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.

Section IV

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
