

ORDINANCE NO. 2114

AN ORDINANCE transferring \$45,000.00 from the General Fund to pay for improvements to Goot Park, appropriating \$10,000.00 to fund the mini-grant program of the United Camas Association of Neighborhoods, and amending the Budget for the year 1997 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the Council has elected to install an irrigation system and regrade and reseed the field at Goot Park, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of such project is \$45,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditure, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to budget an additional \$10,000.00 to the mini-grant program of United Camas Association of Neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the General Fund to pay for such expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$55,000.00 is hereby transferred from the General Fund to pay for improvements to Goot Park and funding the mini-grant program of the United Camas Association of Neighborhoods, and is allocated as follows:

Section II


Ordinance 2096 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 1997 are amended to provide for the aforesated expenditures.

Section III


This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
