

ORDINANCE NO. 2123

AN ORDINANCE adopting a map entitled "City of Camas Archaeological Probability Map, July 1, 1997".

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The Council adopts the following findings:

A. The Growth Management Act requires cities to adopt provisions for the identification and preservation of sites and structures that have historical or archaeological significance.

B. The Western Growth Management Hearings Board has ruled that the City of Camas did not adopt sufficient provisions to identify sites of archaeological significance. The Hearings Board further ruled that the City's regulations designed to preserve archaeological resources were sufficient.

C. The Clark County Department of Assessment and Geographic Information Service has furnished the City with a map entitled "City of Camas Archaeological Probability Map, July 1, 1997" (archaeological site map).

D. The archaeological site map classifies all land within the urban growth boundary of the City with respect to the probability or lack of probability that archaeological resources will be present.

E. The archaeological site map contains five (5) probability levels as follows: low--zero to 20 percent; low medium--20 to 40 percent; moderate--40 to 60 percent; moderate high--60 to 80 percent; and high--80 to 100 percent.

F. The City Council desires to adopt the archaeological site map as the official means for identifying the presence of archaeological sites and resources.

Section II

The City hereby adopts that map entitled "City of Camas Archaeological Probability Map, July 1, 1997" as the means of determining the probability of whether a particular site has archaeological resources.

Section III


This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.

PASSED by the Council and APPROVED by the Mayor this 28<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1997.


