

ORDINANCE NO. 2125

AN ORDINANCE transferring \$2,850.00 from the Emergency Rescue Fund to the General Fund, appropriating \$51,160.00 from the General Fund to pay for the costs of hiring three additional full-time Fire Department personnel, and amending the Budget for the year 1997 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the City intends to hire three additional full-time Firefighters and Paramedics for employment with the City of Camas Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, the cost of salaries and wages, benefits, uniforms, and training of the additional personnel is approximately \$51,160.00 for the months of September, October, November and December, 1997, and

WHEREAS, there is a remaining balance of \$48,310.00 from the unreserved fund balance in the General Fund, and

WHEREAS, there is \$2,850.00 in the Emergency Rescue Fund which is available to be transferred to the General Fund for such costs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$2,850.00 is hereby transferred from the Emergency Reserve Fund to the General Fund.

Section II

The sum of \$51,160.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to pay for costs associated with the hiring of three additional Fire Department personnel, and is allocated as follows:


Section III

Section IV


This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
