

ORDINANCE NO. 2131

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$77,000.00 from the General Fund to appraise and then acquire a residential property to be developed for affordable housing.

WHEREAS, the City has received a community development block grant to aid in developing affordable housing, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to appraise and then acquire one residential property with an existing structure, and then to demolish the structure and develop the property at a higher density, and

WHEREAS, the Community Block Grant funds have been placed in the General Fund and have not been appropriated for any other purpose,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$77,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to appraise and acquire a residential property and to develop the property for affordable housing, and is allocated as follows:

Section II

Ordinance 2096 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 1997 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
