

ORDINANCE NO. 2138

AN ORDINANCE modifying Section 3.B of Ordinance No. 2134 by basing the infiltration and inflow mitigation charge for commercial, light industrial and manufacturing properties upon the maximum daily flow measures in gallons, and adding a new Subsection to Section IV of Ordinance No. 2134 providing for imposition of an infiltration and inflow mitigation charge upon commercial, light industrial, and industrial users who increase their daily maximum flow.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Subsection B of Section III of Ordinance No. 2134 is amended to provide as follows:

B. The infiltration and inflow mitigation charge for properties classified as commercial, light industrial and manufacturing shall be calculated by multiplying \$5.00 per gallon times the projected maximum daily flow measured in gallons.

Section II

There is hereby added to Section IV of Ordinance No. 2134 a new subsection to read as follows:

B. Commercial, light industrial, and industrial users who increase their daily maximum flow due to expansion of facilities or other causes, shall pay an additional infiltration and inflow mitigation charge of \$5.00 per gallon times the increase in maximum daily flow measured in gallons.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
