

ORDINANCE NO. 2144

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 2.44.020 of the Camas Municipal Code by revising the requirements for Trustees of the Library Board.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Section 2.44.020 of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

2.44.020 - City Library Board.

A. There is hereby created by the City Council a City Library Board which shall consist of five (5) trustees, who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the Council, and who shall hold office for five (5) years, excepting that the first appointment shall be for one, two, three, four, and five years, respectively, and thereafter one (1) trustee shall be appointed each year to serve for five (5) years.

B. All trustees shall be electors and residents of the city. If a trustee ceases to be a resident of the city, his or her membership on said board shall terminate forthwith. No trustee shall be appointed to the board of trustees for more than two (2) consecutive terms.


C. The Mayor, by and with the consent of the Council, shall have authority to fill any vacancies in the board. A library trustee shall be removed only by a vote of the Council.


D. The trustees shall not receive a salary or other compensation for services as trustee, but necessary expenses incurred shall be paid for from the Library Fund.

Section II


This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
