

ORDINANCE NO. 2151

AN ORDINANCE altering the seal of the City of Camas.

I

The seal of the City of Camas is hereby altered to be a seal having in the inner circle a design portraying Mt. Hood, and the Columbia River in the background, and evergreen trees in the foreground, and on the outer circle the words "CITY OF CAMAS, WASHINGTON".

II

That the afore described seal as altered be and is hereby adopted as the corporate seal of the City of Camas, and that the same shall be used to authenticate all acts of this corporation.

III

The City Clerk shall have custody of the corporate seal of the City of Camas, and by such official affixed to all acts requiring to be authenticated.

IV

This ordinance shall be in force and effective five (5) days after its publication according to law.
