

ORDINANCE NO. 2152

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 9.20.090 by authorizing certain establishments to utilize punchboards and pull-tabs as a commercial stimulant, and revising the gambling tax for bona fide charitable or nonprofit organizations.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

There is hereby added to Section 9.20.090 a new subsection to provide as follows:

5.28.020 - Certain Gambling Activities Authorized.

C. Any person, association or organization operating an established business primarily engaged in the selling of food or drink for consumption on premises is authorized to utilize punchboards and pull-tabs as a commercial stimulate to such business when licensed, conducted and operated pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 9.46, Revised Code of Washington.

Section II

Subsection 9.20.095(A) is amended to provide as follows:

9.20.095 - Taxation of Punchboards and Pull-tabs.

A. Except for bona fide charitable or nonprofit organizations, there is levied upon and shall be collected from and paid as provided in this section, by every person, association and organization utilizing punchboards and pull-tabs games as authorized hereunder, a tax of five (5%) percent of the gross receipts from such punchboards and pull-tabs.

There is levied upon and shall be collected from every bona fide charitable or nonprofit organization utilizing punchboards and pull-tabs a tax of ten (10%) percent of the gross proceeds less the amount awarded in cash or merchandise prizes.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
