

ORDINANCE NO. 2227

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 3.04 of the Camas Municipal Code, by authorizing the use of warrants for the payment of city obligations.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Section 3.04.010 of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

3.04.010 - Warrants to Pay Bills Authorized by the City Council. The City Clerk may draw warrants on the City Treasurer for the payment of all bills allowed by the Council, and then shall present the warrants to the City Treasurer. If there are sufficient funds to meet the warrants, the City Treasurer, or his authorized designee, shall sign the warrants for payment and then deliver the warrants to the person entitled thereto.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
