

ORDINANCE NO. 2236

AN ORDINANCE repealing Chapter 8.32 of the Camas Municipal Code, which regulated the sale and use of fireworks.

WHEREAS, the Council has recently adopted the 1997 Edition of the Uniform Fire Code, and

WHEREAS, the fire code contains provisions for the regulation of the sale, use, storage, handling, transportation, and permitting of fireworks thus rendering Chapter 8.32 duplicative, now, therefore,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Chapter 8.32 of the Camas Municipal Code is repealed.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
