

ORDINANCE NO. 2260

AN ORDINANCE transferring \$265,000.00 from the general fund to the street fund, appropriating \$265,000.00 from the street fund to pay for certain street improvements that were not provided for in the 2000 budget, and amending the budget for the year 2000 to provide for such expenditures.

WHEREAS, the City desires to undertake certain street improvements consisting of a traffic signal modification at Fourth Avenue and Adams Street with an estimated cost of \$35,000.00, replacement of all street lighting downtown with an estimated cost of \$75,000.00, installation of lighting along Pacific Rim Boulevard with an estimated cost of \$75,000.00, installation of sidewalks on NW 38th Avenue with an estimated cost of \$30,000.00, and additional street overlays with an estimated cost of \$50,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the general fund to pay for such expenditures,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$265,000.00 is hereby transferred from the general fund to the street fund.

Section II

The sum of \$265,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the street fund to pay for certain street improvements as identified above, and is allocated as follows:


Section III
