

ORDINANCE NO. 7282

AN ORDINANCE reenacting Ordinance No. 2251, and amending Section 13.64.010 of the Camas Municipal Code by revising the rates for sanitary sewer service.

WHEREAS, on December 13, 1999, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 2251, which amended Section 13.64.010 of the Camas Municipal Code by revising the rates for sanitary sewer service, and

WHEREAS, Washington voters have approved Initiative 722, which in part invalidates all tax and fee increases adopted by local governments between July 2, 1999, and December 31, 1999, and

WHEREAS, several cities have filed suit challenging the constitutionality of Initiative 722, and

WHEREAS, due to the uncertainty surrounding the passage of Initiative 722 and the legal challenges thereto, the City Council desires to reenact the increase in sanitary sewer rates,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Ordinance No. 2251, which increased the rates for sanitary sewer service, is hereby reenacted, confirmed and ratified effective January 1, 2000.

Section II

Section 13.64.010 of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

13.64.010 - Monthly Sewer Service Charge—Sewer Service Available

All customers shall be charged for sanitary sewer service where sanitary sewer service is available in accordance with the rates set forth in Table 13.64.010.
