

ORDINANCE NO. 2269

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$950,000.00 from the Sewer Treatment Plan Construction Fund to pay for costs in excess of the estimated total project cost for the design, construction, and project management for the sewer treatment plant expansion, and amending the Budget for the Year 2000 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, in 1998 the City ^{budgeted} budgeted for the design, construction, and management of the sewer treatment plan expansion, and

WHEREAS, at the time of originally budgeting for this project, the City could only estimate total project cost as design had not been completed; and

WHEREAS, construction is now complete, and the total project cost has been determined, and

WHEREAS, the total project cost exceeds the original budgeted amount by \$950,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the excess amount will be funded from unappropriated retained earnings which have been financed by a Department of Ecology loan, two public works trust fund loans, and revenue bond proceeds,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$950,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Treatment Plan Construction Fund to pay for costs associated with the design, construction and project management of the sewer treatment plant expansion, and is allocated as follows:

Section II

Ordinance No. 2247 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 2000 are amended to provide for the aforesated expenditure.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
