

ORDINANCE NO. 2300

AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 5.32.210 of the Camas Municipal Code by exempting persons properly licensed in the jurisdiction in which their principal office is located from obtaining a taxicab driver's license issued by the City of Camas.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Section 5.32.210 of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

5.32.210 - Taxicab Driver's License Required

With the exception of any person properly licensed as a taxicab driver in the jurisdiction in which their principal office is located, no person shall operate a taxicab for hire upon the streets of the city, and no person who owns or controls a taxicab shall permit it to be so driven, and no taxicab licensed by the city shall be so driven at any time for hire, unless the driver of the taxicab has obtained and has then in force a taxicab driver's license issued under the provisions of this chapter. Every applicant for a taxicab driver's license shall:

- A. Be of the age of twenty-one years or over.
- B. Be of sound physique, with good eyesight and not subject to epilepsy, vertigo, heart trouble, or any other infirmity of body or mind which might render the applicant unfit for the safe operation of a taxicab; and
- C. Be able to speak, read and write the English language.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
