

ORDINANCE NO. 2305

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$115,000.00 from the Unappropriated Fund balance in the Emergency Rescue Fund to pay for unanticipated personnel expenses and higher costs of medical and other operating supplies than anticipated, and amending the budget for the year 2001 to provide for such expenditures.

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen injuries of personnel, the City has incurred higher personnel expenses for emergency personnel than was budgeted for in the 2001 budget, and

WHEREAS, the City has also incurred higher costs for medical and other operating supplies than anticipated, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the Emergency Rescue Fund to pay for such expenditures,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$115,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Rescue Fund to pay for unanticipated personnel and supply expenses, and is allocated as follows:

Section II

Ordinance No. 2287 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 2001 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
