

ORDINANCE NO. 2326

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$32,000.00 from the Grass Valley Park Fund to pay the costs in excess of the budgeted amount for the improvement of 38<sup>th</sup> Street done in conjunction with the Grass Valley Park development.

WHEREAS, the budget for 2002 included an appropriation for half-street improvements to that portion of 38<sup>th</sup> Street fronting Grass Valley Park, and

WHEREAS, the cost of such improvement exceeded the budgeted amount by \$32,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there are unappropriated funds in the Grass Valley Park Fund to pay for such expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$32,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Grass Valley Park Fund to pay for costs in excess of the budgeted amount for the improvement of 38<sup>th</sup> Street, and is allocated as follows:

Ordinance No. 2303 and the Budget for the City of Camas for the Year 2002 are amended to provide for the aforesated expenditure.


Section III
