

ORDINANCE NO. 2404

AN ORDINANCE amending Subsection 2.72.020(d) of the Camas Municipal Code by revising the eligibility standards for post-retirement medical insurance benefits.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Subsection 2.72.020(d) of the Camas Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

2.72.020 - Benefits Designated

- d. No employee shall be provided, at the City's expense, post-retirement medical insurance coverage from retirement to age 65 unless 1) the employee is entitled to such benefit under the terms of the Employees' Collective Bargaining Agreement; or 2) the employee was hired or promoted to a non-represented position prior to April 15, 2005, or 3) the employee's position was removed from a Collective Bargaining Agreement to a non-represented position prior to April 15, 2005, or 4) the employee was entitled to such benefit under the Employees' Collective Bargaining Agreement and then was promoted to a non-represented position after April 15, 2005.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
