

ORDINANCE NO. 2467

AN ORDINANCE levying the ad valorem taxes
for obligations of the Emergency Medical Services
for fiscal year ending December 31, 2007.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Camas has met and considered its budget for the
calendar year 2007, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Camas after hearing and after duly considering all
relevant evidence and testimony presented, determined that the City of Camas requires a regular
levy in the amount of \$0.35 per thousand of assessed value, per a vote of the people, election held
on September 19, 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CAMAS, that the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the 2007 levy in the amount of
\$0.35 per thousand of assessed value.

A CERTIFIED BUDGET request or estimate is filed with the County Assessor's Office
separate from this ordinance. As required by RCW 84.52.020, that filing certifies the total amount
to be levied by the regular property tax levy. The form for this purpose is titled "Levy
Certification" and is available through the Assessor's Office. Certification is made in a manner
prescribed by the County Assessor's Office.
