

ORDINANCE NO. 2475

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$620,000.00 from the Street Fund to pay for repairs to Forest Home Road, and amending the Budget for 2006 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, Forest Home Road was closed due to a land and mud slide, and

WHEREAS, before the road could be re-opened, the City was required to install drainage adjacent to the roadside and to undertake other stabilization measures, and

WHEREAS, the cost of said repairs was \$620,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the appropriation will be funded with a \$535,774.00 Federal Grant received via the Washington State Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, the remainder of the expense will be funded through un-appropriated monies in the Street Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

There is hereby appropriated from the Street Fund the sum of \$620,000.00, to be allocated as follows:

Section II

Ordinance No. 2431 and the Budget for the year 2006 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditure.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
