

ORDINANCE NO. 2526

AN ORDINANCE levying the ad valorem taxes  
for the Unlimited Tax General Obligation Bonds for  
fiscal year ending December 31, 2009.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Camas has met and considered its budget for the  
calendar year 2009, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Camas after hearing and after duly considering all  
relevant evidence and testimony presented, determined that the City of Camas requires a levy in  
the amount of \$686,980.00, which is a levy on the assessed valuation for the purposes of raising  
funds for payment of bonds and interest for the Unlimited Tax General Obligation Bonds  
authorized by a vote of the electorate of the City of Camas to be paid without limit on the tax levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CAMAS, that a decrease in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the 2009 levy in  
the amount of \$58,763.00 which is a percentage decrease of 7.88% from the previous year.

A CERTIFIED BUDGET request or estimate is filed with the County Assessor's Office  
separate from this ordinance. As required by RCW 84.52.020, that filing certifies the total amount  
to be levied by the regular property tax levy. The form for this purpose is titled "Levy  
Certification" and is available through the Assessor's Office. Certification is made in a manner  
prescribed by the County Assessor's Office.
