

ORDINANCE NO. 2560

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Camas, Washington, creating a Hotel-Motel Lodging Tax Fund, and specifying the uses to be made of monies deposited in said fund.

WHEREAS, the Council has adopted an Ordinance levying an excise tax of two percent (2%) on the sale of or charge made for the furnishing of lodging by any hotel, rooming house, tourist court, bed and breakfast facility, motel, or trailer camp, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to create a separate fund for the receipt and disbursement of the hotel-motel excise tax,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

There is hereby created a special fund to be known as the "Hotel-Motel Lodging Tax Fund", which fund shall be utilized for the receipt and disbursement of the proceeds from the excise tax of two percent (2%) levied on the sale of or charge made for the furnishing of lodging by any hotel, rooming house, tourist court, bed and breakfast facility, motel, or trailer camp.

Section II

Monies in the Hotel-Motel Lodging Tax Fund shall be used only for the purposes authorized for hotel-motel tax revenues by Chapter 67.28, Revised Code of Washington.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
