

ORDINANCE NO. 2577

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$35,000.00 from the Storm Water Drainage Fund to pay for costs incurred from two storm water pond failures, and amending the Budget for the year 2009 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREFORE, there were two storm water pond failures this year resulting in significant water backups, and

WHEREAS, City staff was required to rent excavators and purchase gravel, piping, and rock in order to repair the damage from the storm water pond failures, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated funds in the storm water drainage fund to provide for such expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

There is hereby appropriated from the Storm Water Drainage Fund the sum of \$35,000.00 to pay for repair costs incurred for two storm water pond failures. Said appropriation shall be allocated as follows:

Section II

Ordinance No. 2528 and the Budget for the year 2009 are amended to provide for the aforestated expenditures.

Section III

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
