

ORDINANCE NO. 2588

AN ORDINANCE adding a new Chapter to the Camas Municipal Code establishing a Violations Bureau for the processing of parking violations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

There is hereby added to the Camas Municipal Code a new section to provide as follows:

**2.96.010 Parking Violations Bureau:** There is hereby established a Parking Violations Bureau under the supervision of the Camas Municipal Court to assist in processing parking violation cases. The Parking Violations Bureau shall be administered by the Camas Finance Department. The Camas Municipal Court shall designate by Court Order the specific parking infractions which may be processed by the Parking Violations Bureau. The Parking Violations Bureau shall be authorized to receive the posting of bail for parking offenses specified by the Camas Municipal Court, and to the extent authorized by said Court, shall be authorized to accept forfeiture of bail and payment of penalties for such infractions. The Parking Violations Bureau, upon accepting the prescribed bail, shall issue a receipt therefore to the alleged violator and acknowledging the posting thereof and informing the accused of the legal consequences of bail forfeiture.

The Parking Violations Bureau shall be authorized to process parking infractions in conformity with RCW 46.63 and with the Court Order of the Camas Municipal Court. All penalties and forfeitures paid to the Parking Violations Bureau shall be placed in the City's General Fund.

Section II

This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five days from and after its publication according to law.

This matter having come on regularly before the above-entitled Court upon the petition of the City of Camas for an Order referring traffic infractions to the Camas Parking Violations Bureau, the City of Camas appearing by and through its Attorney, David H. Schultz, and the Court having considered the records and files herein and finding that the proposed Order is authorized by RCW 3.30.090, it is now, therefore,

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** as follows:

1. The Camas Parking Violations Bureau is hereby authorized to process all parking infractions arising under the Ordinances of the City of Camas.
2. Bail for violation of Camas Municipal Code Section 10.08.035 shall be \$50.00. Bail for violation of RCW 46.16.381 shall be \$250.00. Bail for all other parking infractions shall be \$15.00.
3. If bail is not paid or postmarked within 15 days of the violation and no contested or mitigation hearing is requested within 15 days of the violation, there shall be assessed an additional

1 \$25.00.

4. The Parking Violations Bureau is authorized to accept forfeiture of bail and payment of monetary penalties in accordance with this Order, and shall issue a receipt to the alleged violator, which receipt shall inform him of the legal consequences of bail forfeiture.

5. Any request for a contested hearing or mitigation hearing shall be heard by the Court.




