

ORDINANCE NO. 2625

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$85,000.00 from the Equipment Rental Fund for the purchase of a new backhoe, and amending the Budget for the year 2011 to provide for such expenditure.

WHEREAS, the City's 19 year old backhoe that had been planned for replacement in 2012 is no longer operable, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director desires to purchase a new backhoe to be used for summer and fall season projects, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient unappropriated retained earnings in the Equipment Rental Fund to pay for such expenditure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

The sum of \$85,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Equipment Rental Fund to pay for the acquisition of a backhoe. Said appropriation shall be allocated as follows:

Section III


This ordinance shall take force and be in effect five (5) days from and after its publication according to law.
