

RESOLUTION NO. 993

A RESOLUTION establishing a fee for controlled burns conducted by the Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Camas Fire Department is periodically requested by property owners to burn down a dilapidated structure, and

WHEREAS, such controlled burns provide a good training exercise for Fire Department personnel, and

WHEREAS, the cost of a controlled burn is often less than the cost of demolition and removal, and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department incurs significant overtime and other expenses in conducting a controlled burn, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to recoup some of the expense in conducting controlled burns,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Any property owner requesting the Fire Department to conduct a controlled burn of a structure shall pay a fee of \$0.50 per square foot with a minimum charge of \$1,000.00 and a maximum charge of \$2,000.00.
